

WSA SEWERLINE FLUSHING SCHEDULE

The Warwick Sewer Authority (WSA) will be flushing sewer lines in your neighborhood over the next few weeks. The schedule below shows when we anticipate flushing will be performed on your street. The WSA will provide homeowners with 48 hour notice of our flushing activities via door hanger. When flushing has been completed for your street, a completed date will be entered in the last column of the table below.

Properties without a *backflow device* on their sewer service line may experience “back pressure” during line flushing. It is possible that high pressure water being flushed through the lines in the street may make its way into a home’s sewer plumbing line. Air pressure in the line sometimes causes splashing of the toilet water onto the adjacent floor. Therefore it is strongly recommended that you close the lid on your toilet(s) to prevent any back pressure fluids from leaving the toilet.
